Enrolments

Students enrol for classes at the commencement of each year. Our enrolment process is fully online for your convenience! It is important to ensure your contact information is correct as these are the details used in emergency situations.

Enrolments roll over from term to term during a school year. We require at least seven (7) days notice in writing from the time of invoice receipt for class cancellation/changes or term fees are required to be paid in full.

Fees & Accounts Payment

Fees are paid in advance on a term by term basis. Our fee schedule is based on a 10 week term however this will vary in Terms 1 and 4. All prices include GST.

Enrolments attract a \$35 enrolment fee which covers insurance, music licences and class props.

Invoices are emailed at least three (3) weeks prior to each term commencement. **Payment is required by the first day of each term** and can be made by credit card or via bank transfer. Overdue accounts at the due date will automatically incur a \$30 administration fee. If fees remain outstanding, Radiance reserves the right to refuse a child to participate in class until fees are fully paid.

There will be classes held during term time on all pupil free days and public holidays (excluding Anzac Day).

Newsletters

Our Radiance Newsletter is emailed to parents in the first half of each term and provides important information for all parents including key dates, procedural requirements and performance information. Please ensure that you receive your newsletter – sadly, sometimes our Newsletters end up in the recipient's Spam box so it is a good idea to check regularly.

Performance & Non-performance Classes

Radiance has both performance and non-performance classes at Holland Park and Windsor studio locations.



All Mummy & Me and Tiny Tot week-day morning classes are non-performance classes.

All afternoon and Saturday morning classes are <u>performance classes</u> where costuming and public performance opportunities including the annual concert are offered to students.

Non-performance Classes: Holland Park and Windsor week-day morning classes are non-performance classes and do not participate in public performances/annual concert. We aim to keep these classes low-key and stress-free to focus on nurturing the love of dance and movement! Miss Taylor teaches all our Mummy & Me and Tiny Tot Combo morning classes at Holland Park in 2020 and looks forward to a wonderful and exciting year of dance.

'Viewing Week' is held at the end of Term 2. At the end of Term 4, our very exciting 'in-class concert' is held where we offer the purchase of a beautiful dance costume for your little one. The cost is approx. \$66 and the costume needs to be ordered by the specified deadline to ensure delivery. Late orders cannot be processed. Details are provided by email notification at the end of Term 3.

Performance Classes: Each year children are provided with performance opportunities at Mt Gravatt Show in July for Holland Park students and the Ekka in August for Windsor students. Students also display their dance skills gained over the year at the annual concert held at Somerville House Auditorium, South Brisbane.

Costuming and participating in public performances is optional but highly recommended for all students. Parents who do NOT wish their child/ren to participate must 'opt out' with written notification to hello@radiancedance.com by the required date towards the end of Term 1. Failure to 'opt out' by this date means that a costume order will be placed for your children. These costumes are non-returnable and non-refundable items. If you do not wish to incur a costuming charge, please be sure to let us know!

Annual Concert

There are two concerts based on the different student age groups. Both have a **compulsory** dress rehearsal on **Saturday 28 November**.

Show A (Tiny Tot & Prep students ONLY) **Saturday 28 November 4:00pm Show B** (Pre-Junior & over students) **Sunday 29 November 2:00pm**

The concert is optional for all students but participation is strongly recommended. It is the highlight of the year when students get to showcase their skills and have their special moment on stage! It really is magic! Further details will be released in the Term 3 newsletter.

Concert Fees

Concert Pack: Participating students are provided with a concert pack which contains a medal, personalised certificate, show shirt (with their name on it!). The concert pack fee also covers the additional costs associated with prop hire, additional accessories and group rehearsals prior to the concert.

Concert pack prices range from \$90 for Tiny Tots to \$155 for Senior students.

Concert Tickets:

• Show tickets range from \$14 for a child to \$28 for an adult. Concession tickets are available at the reduced cost of \$22.



Concert Recording:

• A video /digital download of the entire show is available at the cost of \$15. It is a compulsory inclusion for all concert participants so that prices can be kept low for everyone.

Costumes

Each year our students are given the opportunity to wear stunning costumes for their performances! We aim to keep prices affordable but the quality high. In 2020, costume packs will range from approximately \$79 for one (1) costume and \$149 - \$159 for two (2) costumes.

Students are measured for their costumes during class in Week 7 of Term 1 and costumes arrive mid-Term 2. Opt out date for costuming/performances is 20 March. After this date, costumes are ordered from our costume supplier and there is a liability for full payment. These costumes are used for public performances during Term 3, studio photos and the annual concert in Term 4.

Uniforms & Grooming

Uniforms: Students in Ballet have a compulsory uniform which must be worn to all classes. Acrobatics students are strongly encouraged to purchase a Radiance uniform to wear at class to ensure maximum safety during class practice. All other styles are also encouraged to wear the uniform to class.

Dance Shoes: Specific dance shoes are required for ballet, jazz, tap, chorus, hip hop, musical theatre and the Theatre/Contemporary and lyrical classes at Windsor studio. Dance shoes should ONLY be worn in the studio so that they are kept in good condition. Students should arrive and leave the studio in alternative footwear.

Grooming: Grooming is an important part of dance and we seek your cooperation to ensure that female students' hair be secured into a neat bun or ponytail for their classes.

All female students require bright red stage lipstick. All other make-up is **optional** for students under 10 years of age.

Eisteddfods

The most regular form of dance competition is the local Eisteddfod. These are conducted throughout the year in the greater Brisbane area and can be a wonderfully rewarding experience for students, providing valuable stage experience and exposure. Additionally, students are offered performance opportunities at various school fetes to showcase their dance routines throughout the year.

Spaces for all 2020 teams are now filled however, please contact Miss Bonnie if you would like more information about 2021 teams. Students involved in this program are offered opportunities through agency auditions such as performing in Brisbane City Youth Ballet, Harvest Rain Theatre Company and The Lord Mayor's Christmas Carols.

In 2019, our Eisteddfod Team travelled to the USA to perform at Disneyland, Universal Studios & Hollywood Boulevard. We are planning another Eisteddfod trip in 2021...stay tuned!!

Dancers wishing to compete in Eisteddfod competitions on a solo basis must have private lessons which will allow for a routine to be choreographed and polished to be stage ready.



Ballet Exams

Our annual ballet exams are constructive in providing feedback and a great opportunity for students to track their progress and achievements! Radiance staff create a caring, positive and fun exam environment where students can feel proud of their developing technique. These exams are compulsory for all students at the cost of \$25 for Prep students and \$35 for Junior, Intermediate and Senior Students.

Ballet students study a combination of Vaganova and Royal Academy of Dance syllabus as well as learning ballet vocabulary. Ballet exams will occur on:

Saturday 13 June between 11:30am – 4:00pm

More information is distributed in Term 1 to all Ballet families.

Choreography Competition

The Radiance Choreography Competition happens mid-Term 3 and is held at St Bartholomew's Hall, Mt Gravatt. This is a competition where the students perform their own choreography in solos, duos, trios or small groups for an audience and a small panel of local judges. This is a wonderful opportunity for students to engage their creative talents to choreograph and perform their own routines!

All students receive a medal and certificate. Further details and entry forms are made available in Term 2. The entry fee is \$40 which covers our costs to hire the venue and external judges.

Student Teacher Education Program

Radiance Dance Academy is proud to be a partner studio with DanceStep offering a four (4) level Student Teacher Education Program which empowers students to take care of others and guides them to be leaders and role models. The program covers teaching skills such as behavioural management, different learning needs and styles, safe dance principles and anatomy just to name a few. The concepts are taught in a sequential and age appropriate way to children from ten years of age.

Students are required to assist within our junior school on a weekly basis as well as complete workbooks in their individual time. Students within the program are committed to the assistant teaching role and display a high level of passion, dedication and enthusiasm.

Whether students are considering a career in dance teaching or otherwise, the DanceStep program is a great preparation for many aspects of life.

Acrobatic Arts Certified Studio

Radiance is an Acrobatic Arts certified studio! Acrobatic Arts in an international training program consisting of 12 levels from beginner to advanced. Students who study acrobatics learn to tumble, aerial and successfully complete partner tricks! Our qualified Acrobatic Arts teachers ensure safety is the number one priority in our Acrobatics classes. We pride ourselves on a high standard of Acrobatics training focusing on perfecting skills and reaching goals.

Make-up / missed lessons

No refund or credit can be given for missed lessons. One (1) make-up lesson can be arranged per term per student for performance and non-performance classes.

No make-up lessons are permitted in Term 4 in performance classes due to concert preparation. All make-up lessons must be booked two (2) working days in advance by contacting us at hello@radiancedance.com.

Child Collection & Safety

Safety of your children is our top priority at all times!

For <u>Holland Park studio</u>, children aged 9 years and under (Tiny Tots, Preps, & Junior students) must be collected from the courtyard area at the back of the studio after classes.

Windsor students should be collected from inside the hall.

Children must be fully supervised by a parent/guardian outside class times. We encourage parents of Tiny Tot students to stay at the studio whilst children are at classes.

Your prompt arrival to collect your child is important - both as a courtesy to Radiance staff and for the well-being of your child! It is strongly recommended that you arrive 5 - 10 minutes before the scheduled end of class time to allow for any unforeseen circumstances that may occur on your journey.
